Please be advised that this office serves as solicitor for West Rockhill Township, Intervenor in the above-captioned matter. I am writing to you because, just yesterday, the Township received, from the Bucks County Conservation District ("BCCD") a letter, accompanied by a plan, showing the location of the proposed staging and construction material areas. As has been indicative of our experience with Adelpia, this information was provided by the BCCD, in spite of numerous requests from the Township to Adelpia to provide the same information.


The proposal seeks to utilize wetland areas as the staging area for the construction of the compressor station. This aspect of construction was not addressed in the EA, further illustrating the need for an EIS to properly evaluate the impact of construction on environmentally sensitive areas.

The information provided to us by BCCD notes that the plan was based on Site Survey, Civil and Architectural Plans prepared by HGA. Early in the process, Adelpia supplied the Township with the basic site plan prepared by HGA, but the basic site plan lacked the specific detail necessary to develop the BCCD plan. The Township has not been given the other plans referenced in the BCCD documents. The Township can only reach the conclusion that Adelpia is making every effort to avoid providing the requested information to the Township.

Once again, we question why the compressor station is proposed for a parcel too small to accommodate the construction activity. Adelpia owns larger parcels, nearby, and along the pipeline. We ask that an EIS be required to determine the impacts of this proposal on our environmental resources in order to insure that the best decisions are being made.
